A legacy or bequest to your local RSPCA will provide crucial funds and we could not carry out our work without such generous support.

You can do this by making a will or adding a codicil. If you are making a will then please remember that the West Norfolk RSPCA Rehoming Centre is a separately registered charity. If you would like the animals in your local area to benefit then we respectfully suggest that your legacy wording reads:

I give the sum of £ (or specify a share of residue) to the West Norfolk RSPCA Rehoming Centre (Registered Charity Number 206572), Eau Brink Bank, Tilney All Saints, King's Lynn, Norfolk PE34 4SG, for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer of the said RSPCA for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.

To add a codicil you will need to ask your solicitor to draw up a codicil for you. Please note that a will or codicil needs to be properly witnessed.

A registered charity is exempt from inheritance and capital gains taxes. A gift to the West Norfolk RSPCA Rehoming Centre would therefore be tax exempt and would greatly benefit our charity without placing a burden on your estate.
